Michigan Soccer Association Indoor Rules

Game Rules:

All games played by MSA affiliated teams shall be conducted under the rules as published by FIFA in its "Laws of the Game" with the following exceptions:

- 1) All players must be registered with the MSA for the 2019 season.
- 2) 22 players are permitted on the "Player Pool Roster".
- 3) 18 players are permitted on the "Game Roster".
- 4) Unlimited substitutions are allowed per game. Substitutions can be made at any time. A player that is leaving the field to be substituted must leave the field at the closest sideline and cannot contact the ball (yellow card penalty).
- 5) All games shall be two 30 minute halves.
- 6) If a game is tied at the end of the second half, kicks from the penalty mark (per FIFA Law) shall decide the winner.
- 7) Games must start on time. Referees will start the game at the scheduled time.
- 8) If a team is a no-show or does not complete a game, a \$500 fine will be assessed to the team's respective league.
- 9) Red carded players shall be suspended for two of the remaining tournament games. The MSA may increase or add other penalties as the behavior warrants.
- 10) MSA will permit a non-registered player to play in the indoor tournament with a USASA Liability Waiver for the registration cost of \$10.00.
